

BOOT Party WhatsApp Group Guidelines

However, when creating any BOOT Party related WhatsApp group, the following guidelines MUST be followed.

Creating a new BOOT Party WhatsApp Group

The BOOT Party WhatsApp Group:

1. MUST have the BOOT Party General WhatsApp Numbers

2. MUST have the official BOOT Party Logo.
3. Name MUST begin with 'The BOOT Party – '. **No personal name should be included in the group name or description of the group.**
4. MUST include these texts in the WhatsApp group's description: **The BOOT Party, Because Of Our Tomorrow as a political leadership system is poised to put Nigeria on the path of progress, negotiate meaning among Nigerian ethnic groups, and build a nation of collaborators and not competitors. BOOT Party will develop solidarity of friendship among all Nigerian ethnic nationalities and implement nationwide policies and One Working Nigeria (OWN) agenda to reposition Nigeria for greatness and for the black race.**

By joining this group, you agree that you have read and will follow the BOOT Party Terms and conditions and the guidelines set for WhatsApp Group. You also agree to abide by all relevant policies and procedures of the BOOT Party.

3. Check that the name of the particular BOOT Party WhatsApp Group begins with 'The BOOT Party'

How to Report a rogue WhatsApp group?

1. Draw the attention of the particular BOOT Party WhatsApp Group to the details in this document.
2. If nothing changes after 24 hours please follow the steps below.
3. Take screenshot of the number of the administrator's number.
4. Send this screenshot with your names to the BOOT Party General WhatsApp Number
